Subject: Retraction of previous grievance towards Public Safety Officer,
Roger Purcell and Chief Gerald Mayeda

On the eighth of January, 1988, I submitted a letter of grievance pointing out the unfair treatment towards my husband, VPSO Jeff Luse that has been occurring since he has worked at the Public Safety Office. I would like to exclude and apologize about the statement concerning the Purcell's possible marital problems, because I don't believe it is relevant to the most important point I am trying to get across.

It was originally supposed to make you aware of the tactics that Roger Purcell has been using to twist situations in his favor at any cost to individuals he deals with, particularly VPSO Luse. However, though I have omitted the statement and apologized, it is important to re-emphasize the concern I have for my husband and anyone else who has to work with Purcell, as well as my concern for the residents of Hoonah. This is not to leave out Chief Gerald Mayeda, who backs Purcell with his attempts to manipulate with fear, as I have observed with the way they have treated my husband.
