To Officer Bolton

On December 21st at approximately 1630 hours Chief Mayeda and myself instructed you to pick up dogs while on duty. During this meeting you refused to pick up dogs because you felt it was inhumane. You were informed that the kennels were adequate for keeping the animals for three days. Chief Mayeda gave you a direct order to pick up dogs which you refused again and then left the office slamming our office door, hard enough to knock down the bulletin board off the wall.

Your conduct was unacceptable as an employee of this Department and you will be suspended from work for two days without pay. You will turn in your badge, gun and identification on Sunday December 27th at 0800 hours to Chief Mayeda. You will then pick up your badge, gun and identification on Tuesday December 29th at 0800 hours from Chief Mayeda. During this time you will not identify yourself as a police officer or perform any duties as a police officer until your suspension is completed. Any further action like this will be grounds for dismissal in the future. This letter will stay in your personal file for one year. If there are no other violations during this time this will be removed from your file and destroyed. You have five days to appeal this suspension in writing to me or Chief Mayeda.

I have read the letter of suspension and understand the content and understand I have five days to appeal.
