Subj: Official Misconduct

Officer Bolton

On January 20, 1988 you violated the regulation of maximum allowed time by a relative inside the station without approval of a supervisor. Cathy Bolton was in the station for over 8 hours. Regulation states that relatives or friends will not be in the station for more than five minutes.

On January 20, 1988 you violated the regulation on the copier. You allowed Cathy Bolton to use the copier and failed to get approval of a supervisor. You also failed to mark how many copies that Cathy Bolton made and pay \$0.03 for each copy as is required by regulation.

On January 20, 1988 you allowed Cathy Bolton into the records of this department without approval of a supervisor. Federal law requires that certain files to be kept in confidence and you allowed Cathy Bolton free access to the department files, you violated city personal rules on confidentiality. Cathy Bolton also informed Dispatcher Wilson that the information she was gathering was for an attorney. You have been informed that all information being sent out must be reviewed by a supervisor before being sent to any agency.

Because of the seriousness of these violations you are being suspended with pay. During your suspension you will not identify yourself as a police officer or perform any duties as a police officer. You will report to the Chief's office at 1100 hours on Monday 01 Feb 88. At this time I will be recommending your termination for official misconduct or except your resignation.
